

An Open Book (AOB) Foundation takes authors and illustrators to underserved schools in the DC metro area and sends every student attending the event home with a signed book. In addition, AOB gives a book to each classroom and a set of the author/illustrator's books to the school library.

- Once you and/or your school have signed up with AOB using the form below, we will be in touch with you about scheduling events.
- We schedule events throughout the school year for grades pre K through 12. In order for as many children as possible to benefit from our program, we host one event per classroom per school year, but we often return to the same school and visit different classrooms.
- The school is responsible for ensuring the event's success by providing adequate space and preparing students in advance.

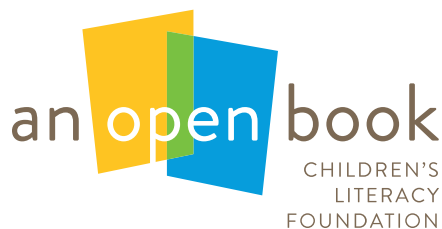
Here are some tips to help you prepare:

1. Consider doing an author/illustrator study, in which the students read and discuss several books by the visiting author/illustrator.
2. Download and print out curricular materials from the author/illustrator's website.
3. Familiarize yourself and your students with the author/illustrator. Read the "bio" section on his/her website or in his/her books.
4. Have your students think of questions they want to ask the author/illustrator.

Please note: An Open Book staff member usually photographs events. AOB may use these photos on its website or in its publicity materials. If the school does not have release forms on file, AOB will provide the school with a consent form to be signed by each parent allowing the children to be photographed and the photos to be used as described above. If this is a problem for your school, please discuss it with AOB when you schedule your event.
